

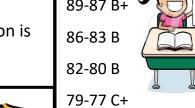

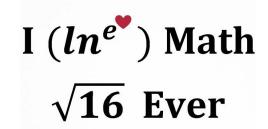

LATE WORK POLICY:

Homework completion is essential to success in Algebra II. All homework assignments must be completed in pencil or erasable pen. One late paper per week is allowed for full credit. Any other assignments that are not submitted on the due date will be considered "missing." Late/Missing work may still be turned in for partial credit until test day. NO papers will be accepted after the cumulative Unit Test has been taken.

Retake Policy:

Students have the opportunity to retake tests outside of regular class time as outlined in the following bullets. Re-taking a unit test is a privilege. In order to earn that privilege, a student must give "valiant effort" on the original test. (Valiant effort includes, but is not limited to: the test must be complete, there is valid work shown on every question, the score is similar to formative scores earned in the unit, etc.)

- > Students have the option to retake the test as long as each assignment was completed on time (including the review and take-home quiz) prior to the original test date. If a student chooses to retake the test, he/she:
 - Will take a complete unit test of the equivalent length and difficulty, but not identical to the original test.
 - Will earn the higher of the two scores.
 - Must attend at least one study session with an Algebra II teacher outside of class time to complete a reflection sheet and discuss missed problems on the original test. (This study session cannot be on the same day as the retake)
 - Must complete their retake within 2 weeks of the date when the original tests are returned to the class.
 - The Last test of each semester may not be retaken.
