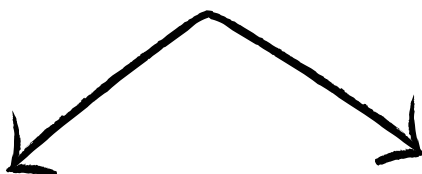


# 8th Grade Algebra 1

Middle School students taking Algebra 1 will have the opportunity to earn high school credit! Middle school Algebra 1 mirrors the course being taught at the high school level (content, rigor, grading). To ensure that students have a strong foundation prior to moving to the next math course, district parameters have been put in place.

In order to be eligible to earn credit a student must earn a grade of B- or higher in each of the first three terms.

Upon meeting the grade requirement, the student/family can determine if they want to count the high school credit or retake Algebra 1 during their freshman year.



## High School Credit

- Students that meet the grade requirement and choose to receive the credit will take the Algebra 1 End of Course exam in place of the 8th grade math MAP assessment.
- 8th Grade Algebra 1 credit will not be included into high school GPA.
- Students will move to the next math course their freshman year.

## No High School Credit

- Students who did not earn a B- or higher will take the 8th grade math MAP assessment.
- Students that choose to not receive high school credit will take the 8th grade math MAP assessment.
- Students will retake Algebra 1 freshman year.
