



Book Introduction			Reread Yesterday's Book		
<div> Click on the video icon and watch the Book Introduction</div>			As your child reads today, listen for the tricky parts. Count the number of errors. An error is when your child makes a mistake and NEVER fixes it. If your child fixes the error, this is a good thing and shouldn't be counted! Is the book too easy (few errors), too hard (many errors that are causing him/her to be frustrated), or just right (balance of some challenging words, but can solve most words).		
Read with Help from You (Prompting)					
<u>Try some of these other prompts if your child is still stuck:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Try something. What can you try? (Praise any attempt)• Say the first part and reread.• Does that make sense? Find the tricky part.• Try that again and think what would make sense.• Check the middle (or end) of the word. What would make sense and look right?• Cover the ending. Find a part you know. Break the word.

Day 1: After reading, discuss these parts of the book: What was the problem of the story? What was the solution?			Day 2: After reading, discuss these parts of the book: What happened in the beginning of the story? The middle? The end?
