COURSE DESCRIPTION

Prerequisite: Successful completion of Algebra 1 or Algebra 1A/1B

Geometry emphasizes reasoning and logical thinking. This course connect: geometry to Algebra and Trigonometry. Specific topics include basic geometry, transformations, triangles, the Cartesian Coordinate system similarity, probability, area of plane figures, surface area and volume o solids. This is a course for students who expect to continue their study o mathematics in high school, technical school, or college.




