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
We have been working hard at learning and practicing our 1st grade and Belair expectations!

This week our learned focused on the number 10 while we continued to apply a level 3 strategy of making easier, yet equivalent problems by seeing and making a group of 10.

Decomposing an addend in a two-digit number sentence to create a ten and a three-addend expression may not come natural and seem easier at first, but with practice, it becomes easier than counting all or counting on. As students get better at using the make a ten strategy, they will deepen their number sense and form a foundation for the strategy of using benchmark numbers to find larger sums. Through Module we will continue to practice multiple math strategies and building our fluency with facts to 20.
