This week we continued working through Topic B: Length Measurement and Comparison. This week we encountered longer lengths thus our introduction to the 10-centimeter sticks that became a more efficient tool for us to find the length of longer objects.

Building on what we have learned and know about tens and ones has helped us make a connection and see/understand the importance of changing our measurement tool to the 10-centimeneter sticks instead of the centimeter cubes. Knowing number sense, understanding two-digit numbers and how to count tens and ones has helped us to quickly apply and use the 10-centimeter sticks to measure and find an objects length.
