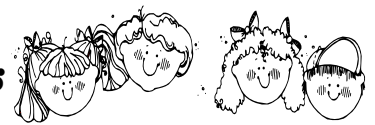

## = MATH

This week we explored Topic C: Comparison Word Problems with Measurement. This week we've applied all that we've already learned about measurement and advanced our application and thinking as we applied our skills to word problems such as:

Compare with different unknown

Compare with bigger quantity (longer length) unknown

Compare with smaller quantity (shorter length) unknown.

We've been using concrete materials (centimeter cubes and 10 sticks) to help us understand and measure an object's length. This week while working with word problems we transitioned to creating drawings for our tens stick and/or centimeter cubes. Our drawings were not to scale, which required us to understand that longer boxes represented 10 cubes and the small squares represented centimeter cubes. Our drawings were a visual representation of sticks and cubes that allowed us to find the difference without an equation.
