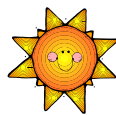
NOW OPEN

Acceptable proof of residency includes: Utility bill; Cable/satellite bill; Internet bill; Housing contract; Monthly mortgage statement; social Services document. Proof of residency can be uploaded within the online registration system, or you may provide it directly to your student's school.
