




This week we continued to work through Module 5: Units of Ten. This week we began exploring Topic C – Addition of one-digit and two-digit numbers.

This week we've applied our place value understanding of tens and ones as we worked to add a two-digit numbers with a one-digit number. We've used a variety of models this week as support. Models we've used include: cubes, drawings, number paths, counting beads and tens and ones models.

Looking for patterns in numbers as well as finding the missing number, what do the digits in the tens and ones place identify, modeling a 2-digit number with tens and ones and solving for a total were our learning targets this week.
