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SUMMER SLIDE

This year has been hard, this year has been stressful, this year has had changes AND this year has been rewarding and amazing! Don't let all our hard work slide away this summer! Did you know 'summer slide' is a term educators use to reference the regression a student can have over summer break. The 'summer slide' has been extensively researched and has shown some shocking facts -----

 ${}^{\blacksquare}$ On average a child facing the 'summer slide' can lose up to 2 months of academic learning in both reading and math

 ${\rm I\!I\!I}$ Students that have faced the summer slide will need approximately 4 to 6 weeks of reteaching the next year.

Easy ideas to help your child stay engaged, thinking and learning over Summer break 20 minutes of Daily reading (independently, to or with your child), book talks (retelling – characters, setting, problem and solution, asking your child their opinion about the book.). Word Hunts: around the house, in the car or even in the store. Tell your child a word you see and have them search their surroundings until they find your word.



MATH challenges: identify more or less items in the pantry, plates, spoons, forks. Number relationships (what does a number look like, create the number in tens and ones, count 10 more or less mentally) and continued practice with time & money. Plan Time: 12:55 - 1:45
