READY, SET. TEST!

Over the last couple of weeks we've taking several district required assessments to find out what your child knows, where they are in their learning process and most importantly how can I help them grow as a learner. All students have taken the beginning of year i-Ready diagnostic, The Word Recognition Assessment, Pseudoword Reading Assessment and the Code Knowledge Diagnostic Assessment.

- i-Ready: is a standardized computer program used to determine your child's strengths and areas for growth. Students test in both Reading and Math. The reading portion assess your child over phonological awareness, phonics, high frequency words, vocabulary and fiction and non-fiction reading comprehension. Math categories include number sense, algebraic understanding geometry and measurement.
- * The Word Recognition Assessment: is designed to provide a quick review of students' ability to recognize and read words.
- Pseudoword Reading Assessment: designed to give a better understand of students' knowledge of sound/spelling correspondences and how they blend words together.
- Code Knowledge Diagnostic Assessment: Used to show students' knowledge of letter identification and associated sound.
