Genius Loci Scholarship-\$1000-1 Award (Deadline: 11/30/2018)

Applicant must be a legal resident of the U.S. or Puerto Rico and be at least 13 years of age and enrolled or will enroll in a college or university in the U.S.

Barbara Lotze Scholarships for Future Teachers-\$2000-5 Awards (Deadline: 12/1/2018)

Applicant must be a high school senior accepted for enrollment into an accredited two-year college or four year college/university and planning to pursue a course of study leading toward a career in physics teaching at the high school level.

Look Twice, Save A Life Scholarship-\$1000-1 Award (Deadline: 12/1/2018)

Applicants must be a college student or plan on attending college in 2019-2020 and must have a valid license.

Stephen J. Brady Stop Hunger Scholarship-\$5000-5 Awards (Deadline: 12/5/2018)

Applicant must be enrolled in an accredited educational institution in the U.S. and have demonstrated on-going commitment to their community by performing volunteer services.

AXA Achievement Scholarship-\$25,000-52 Awards (Deadline: 12/14/2018)

Applicant must be a current high school senior who plans to enroll full-time in an accredited two-year or four-year college and be a U.S. citizen or legal resident living or claiming residency in one of the 50 United States, Washington D.C., or Puerto Rico.
