Good morning and THANK YOU to everyone that asked great questions regarding graduation! I believe the FAQ list below will answer all that I have received so far:

- Is there a limit to the number of guests that I can bring? We are NOT issuing tickets for graduation; each graduate may invite whomever they feel comfortable attending. Please keep in mind that social distancing will be the responsibility of each attendee.
- Will I get to walk across the stage? Yes! Graduates will still walk across the stage; pause for a photo and return to your seat. We have given awards and recognitions in the past unassociated with the actual diploma; we will do so this year, but those recipients will only be recognized from their seat area (stand to be recognized).
- Will I receive my diploma the same day as graduation? No- In an effort to minimize the need to gather in smaller spaces and tightly spaced lines, we will be handing out diplomas the week after graduation during normal business hours (as well as any awards or recognitions that students may receive).
- What is the Dress Code for graduation? The dress code remains the same; Cap and Gown must be worn at all times. Students may NOT decorate or adorn their cap or gown with any personal messages; please feel free to do so afterward. The ceremony is for the Class of 2020 and not for individual statements; any deviation from the dress code will result in the student being prohibited to participate in the ceremony. Please avoid wearing any high heeled shoes; students will be walking across the football field and negotiating the stairs and stage. Please help avoid a potentially embarrassing moment by wearing sensible shoes. :)
- Will we have a graduation practice? We may; however we do not have the details at this time. Please continue to monitor your student email for more information.
