Reminders

- Students will need a backpack this year as we will not be using lockers. Students will carry backpacks with them from class to class.
- Though we encourage students to leave cellular and other electronic devices at home, should they need to bring them to school, we ask that those devices stay within their backpacks throughout the course of the school day. Should parents need to contact students during school hours, the appropriate method of contact is through the front office.

- Please remind students that their foreheads need to be exposed as they enter the building so the thermal cameras may take their temperature upon entering the building.
- Students are encouraged to <u>bring 1 to 2 clean masks</u> with them to school each day. Students are expected to wear their masks in the hallways and anywhere a social distance of 6 feet cannot be maintained.
- Please have students <u>charge their Chromebooks each night</u> at home and leave their chargers at home during the school day so they do not get misplaced.
