<p><b>7</b> Write a story about the things you like to do with your pet: elephant, tiger, zebra, etc. Make it funny!</p>	<p><b>8</b> Start with this problem, and develop a story: "It was midnight, and suddenly the lights went out..."</p>	<p><b>9</b> Write a story about "the time my teacher forgot to wear shoes"....</p>
