New Automated Attendance Call Feature

With the start of this new school year, LCMS we will be implementing a new automated attendance call feature. The calls will come from the same notification system the district currently uses, and therefore from the same phone number.



Here's how the feature works:

- If your student is marked absent when attendance is taken at the start of 1st period/block, and you as his/her parent has not already notified the school attendance desk, a call will be placed at 9:20am to the primary guardian cell phone number on file for your student. That call will tell you that your child has not shown up for class that morning. You will then be instructed to contact the LCMS attendance desk and clear the absence.
- If your student's absence has not been cleared by the end of the school day, another automated call will be made at 7:05pm to that same cell phone number. This call will detail the specific periods/blocks for which your student was absent. You will once again be instructed to contact the attendance desk and clear the absence.

We hope this change will do two things:

1. Improve student attendance at LCMS, and
2. Allow office staff in the building to use their time and resources more effectively and efficiently.
