Important details include:

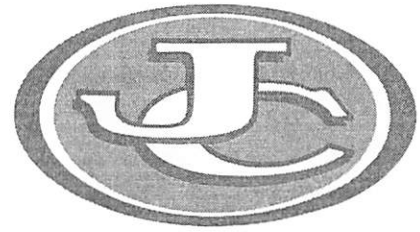
- Place:** Thomas Jefferson Middle School or Lewis & Clark Middle School
- Dates:** Week 1: May 28-May 31 (Tuesday - Friday)
Week 2: June 3-6 (Monday - Thursday)
Week 3: June 10-13 (Monday - Thursday)
Week 4: June 17-20 (Monday - Thursday)
- Hours:** 7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.
Students may NOT arrive before 7:00 a.m.
- Cost:** There will be no charge for the summer school program
- Meals:** Breakfast and lunch will be provided at no cost to students
Breakfast will be served beginning at 7:00 a.m.
- Transportation:** Transportation will be provided for those who are bus eligible
- Grades:** Incoming 7th-8th grade students for 2019-2020 school year
