At West Elementary School, we provide students with "I can" statements to set a purpose for our learning each day. Our learning goals for this week are...

Literacy:

- *I can compare and contrast information within and across fiction and nonfiction.
- *I can explain text to world connections.
- *I can compare and contrast to determine the differences between a biography and autobiography.
- *I can explain examples of sound devices, literal/nonliteral meanings and figurative language in nonfiction texts.

Math:

*I can solve two step problems.

We will be reviewing and taking our division test when we return.

Writer's Workshop:

- *I can revise my writing.
- *I can use specific, relevant words.
- *I can use correct subject/verb agreement.

Science:

- *I can construct an argument with evidence that some changes caused by heating or cooling can be reversed and some cannot
- *I can **PREDICT** and **INVESTIGATE** that water can change from a liquid to a solid (freeze), and back again (melt), or from a liquid to a gas (evaporation), and back again (condensation) as the result of temperature changes.
