#### Literacy:

\*I can compare and contrast the most important points and key details among nonfiction texts on the same topic.

#### Math:

\*I can multiply and divide with numbers and results within 100.

#### Writer's Workshop:

- \*I can find relevant sources to answer my question.
- \*I can reference sources or authors within my piece.
- \*I can locate information related to my topic and take notes.

### Science:

- \*I can construct an argument with evidence that some changes caused by heating or cooling can be reversed and some cannot
- \*I can **PREDICT** and **INVESTIGATE** that water can change from a liquid to a solid (freeze), and back again (melt), or from a liquid to a gas (evaporation), and back again (condensation) as the result of temperature changes.
