At West Elementary School, we provide students with "I can" statements to set a purpose for our learning each day. Our learning goals for this week are...

Literacy:

- *I can connect words and pictures in informational text.
- *I can distinguish literal and nonliteral meanings of words.

Math:

- *I can divide by 5, 10, 3, 6 and 7.

Writer's Workshop:

- *I can identify relevant sources to answer my research question.
- *I can take simple notes on my research.
- *I can sort research on an organizer.

Science:

- *I can construct an argument with evidence that some changes caused by heating or cooling can be reversed and some cannot
- *I can **PREDICT** and **INVESTIGATE** that water can change from a liquid to a solid (freeze), and back again (melt), or from a liquid to a gas (evaporation), and back again (condensation) as the result of temperature changes.
