At West Elementary School, we provide students with "I can" statements to set a purpose for our learning each day. Our learning goals for this week are...

Literacy:

- *I can express my opinion of read alouds.
- *I can use academic vocabulary when speaking.

Math:

- *I can identify a number line is divided into equal parts of a given whole.
- *I can identify the interval from zero to one on a number line is a whole unit.
- *I can explain that a fraction represents the distance from zero on a number line.
- *I can identify fractions as points on a number line.
- *I can describe numerator as part of the whole and denominator as total number of pieces that make the whole.

Writer's Workshop:

- *I can state an opinion or establish a position.
- *I can use my own words except when quoting a source.
- *I can use a prewriting strategy to plan a draft.
- *I can reference author's name or source.
- *I can use specific and relevant words.

At home practice of multiplying single digits would be beneficial to your child. Also practice with telling time and counting money.
