Literacy:

*I can distinguish the literal and non-literal meanings of words and phrases in context.

Math:

WE WILL BE TAKING OUR AREA AND PERIMETER UNIT TEST ON TUESDAY. STUDY GUIDE WILL COME HOME ON MONDAY.

- *I can understand what a unit fraction is.
- *I can describe the numerator as the number of pieces being considered and the denominator as the number of pieces that make the whole.
