At West Elementary School, we provide students with "I can" statements to set a purpose for our learning each day. Our learning goals for this week are...

Literacy:

*I can describe cause/effect relationships. *I can explain the relationship between problems and solutions while reading nonfiction.

<u>Math</u>:

*I can understand that rectangles can have equal perimeters but different areas, or rectangles can have equal areas but different perimeters.

Writer's Workshop:

*I can state an opinion or establish a position and provide reasons for the opinion/position.

Social Studies:

*I can create and use artifacts to share information on social studies' topics.

*I can identify facts and opinions in social studies' topics. can identify and describe the historical significance of influential Missourians.

<u>Science:</u>

*I can **obtain** and **combine** information to **describe** climates in different regions of the world.

*I can **represent** data in tables and graphical displays to **describe** typical weather conditions expected during a particular season.
