At West Elementary School, we provide students with "I can" statements to set a purpose for our learning each day. Our learning goals for this week are...

Literacy:

- *I can explain if a statement is a fact or opinion.
- *I can express my opinion of read alouds and independent reading.

Math:

- *I can identify equal parts of a given whole.
- *I can write fractions that represent the shaded part of a whole.
- *I can describe the numerator as part of the whole.
- *I can describe the denominator as the total number of pieces that make the whole.
- *I can identify a number line is divided into equal parts of a given whole.
- *I can identify the interval from zero to one on a number line is one whole unit.
- *I can explain that a fraction represents the distance from zero on a number line.
- *I can identify fractions as points on a number line.

Writer's Workshop:

- *I can express my opinion of read alouds in my independent writing.

At home practice of multiplying single digits would be beneficial to your child. Also practice with telling time and counting money.
