At West Elementary School, we provide students with "I can" statements to set a purpose for our learning each day. Our learning goals for this week are...

### Literacy:

- \*I can draw conclusions and support with text evidence.
- \*I can identify the main idea using text features and identify details that support the main idea.

#### Math:

- \*I can calculate area by using unit squares to cover a plane figure with no gaps or overlaps.
- \*I can label area measurements with squared units.
- \*I can demonstrate that tiling a rectangle to find the area and multiplying the side lengths result in the same value.
- \*I can multiply whole-number side lengths to solve problems involving the area of rectangles.

#### Writer's Workshop:

- \*I can decide on a main idea.
- \*I can address an appropriate audience.
- \*I can introduce a topic being studied.

#### Science:

- \*I can construct an argument with evidence that some changes caused by heating or cooling can be reversed and some cannot.
- \*I can PREDICT and INVESTIGATE that water can change from a liquid to a solid (freeze), and back again (melt), or from a liquid to a gas (evaporation), and back again (condensation) as the result of temperature changes.

#### Social Studies:

- \*I can create and use artifacts to share information on social studies' topics.
- \*I can identify facts and opinions in social studies' topics. can identify and describe the historical significance of influential Missourians.
