This week's I can statements:

ELA (Unit 7):

- *I can apply common spelling patterns to decode multisyllabic words
- *I can draw conclusions and support the conclusions with textual evidence.
- *I can explain how prefixes and suffixes change the meaning of root words.
- *I can infer and draw conclusions to describe relationships among events, ideas, and concepts.
- *I can infer and draw conclusions to describe cause-and-effect relationships in nonfiction.
- *I can infer and draw conclusions to compare or contrast the most important points and key details among nonfiction texts on the same topic.
- *I can write informational texts
- *I can produce simple and compound imperative, exclamatory, declarative and interrogative sentences.
