At West Elementary School, we provide students with "I can" statements to set a purpose for our learning each day. Our learning goals for this week are...

Literacy:

- *I can follow and explain multistep directions.
- *I can describe relationships among events, ideas, and concepts while reading nonfiction.

Math:

- *I can interpret quotients of whole numbers.
- *I can describe in words or drawings a problem that illustrates a multiplication or division situation.
- *I can multiply and divide with numbers and results within 100.

Writer's Workshop:

- *I can create a list of topics to research.

Social Studies:

In addition to research/reading standards for this unit, students will work on the following:

- *I can explain the major purposes of the Missouri Constitution.
- *I can identify and explain the functions of the 3 branches of government in Missouri.

Science:

*I can construct an argument with evidence that some changes caused by heating or cooling can be reversed and some cannot

*I can **PREDICT** and **INVESTIGATE** that water can change from a liquid to a solid (freeze), and back again (melt), or from a liquid to a gas (evaporation), and back again (condensation) as the result of temperature changes.
