This week's I can statements:

ELA (Quarter 4):

- *I can apply common spelling patterns to decode multisyllabic words
- *I can read high frequency words.
- *I can draw conclusions and support the conclusions with textual evidence.
- * I can infer and draw conclusions to describe relationships among events, ideas, and concepts.
- *I can infer and draw conclusions to describe cause-and-effect relationships in nonfiction.
- *I can infer and draw conclusions to compare or contrast.
- *I can summarize a story and determine message.
- *I can sequence events.
- *I can determine problem/solution.
- *I can determine meaning of multiple meaning words.
- *I can write informational texts
- * I can produce simple and compound imperative, exclamatory, declarative and interrogative sentences.

Math: (Unit 6 – Data, Measurement and Time)

- *I can solve problems involving addition and subtraction of minutes.
- *I can measure length, liquid volume and weight of objects;
- *I can use the four operations to solve problems involving lengths, liquid volumes or weights given in the same units.
- *I can solve one- and two-step problems using information presented in bar and/or picture graphs.
- *I can use data shown in a line plot to answer questions.

Science:

- *I can compare and contrast observations on the life cycle of different plants and animals.
- *I can construct scientific arguments to support claims that some characteristics of organisms are inherited from parents, and some are influenced by the environment.

Math: (Unit 7 – 2D Shapes)

- *I can identify common attributes of a set of given shapes.
- *I can identify contrasting attributes of a set of given shapes.
- *I can classify rhombuses and rectangles, including squares, as quadrilaterals.
- *I can identify examples of quadrilaterals that are not examples of rhombuses and rectangles.
