At West Elementary School, we provide students with "I can" statements to set a purpose for our learning each day. Our learning goals for this week are...

Literacy:

We will be reviewing our reading standards, in addition to preparing for testing through our Schoolnet Map practice tests.

Math:

- *I can solve problems involving addition and subtraction of minutes.
- *I can measure or estimate length, liquid volume and weights of objects.
- *I can use the four operations to solve problems involving lengths, liquid volumes or weights given in the same units.

Writer's Workshop:

We will continue reviewing grammar concepts such as using reference works and capitalizing titles.

Science:

- *I can make a claim about the merit of a solution to a problem caused when the environment changes and the types of plants and animals that live there may change.
- *I can make a claim about the merit of a design solution that reduces the impacts of weatherrelated hazards.

Social Studies:

- * I can define economy and give examples of different types of economies.
- * I can define taxes and explain how taxes are generated and used.
- *I can explain supply and demand.
- *I can conduct a personal cost-benefit analysis.
