#### Literacy:

We will be reviewing our reading standards, in addition to preparing for testing through our Schoolnet Map practice tests.

### <u>Math</u>:

\*I can use data shown in a line plot to answer questions.

\*I can solve problems involving addition and subtraction of minutes.

## Writer's Workshop:

We will be reviewing grammar concepts such as coordinating conjunctions and complex sentences.

### <u>Science:</u>

\*I can make a claim about the merit of a solution to a problem caused when the environment changes and the types of plants and animals that live there may change.

\*I can make a claim about the merit of a design solution that reduces the impacts of weatherrelated hazards.

# <u>Social Studies:</u>

\* I can define economy and give examples of different types of economies.

\* I can define taxes and explain how taxes are generated and used.

\*I can explain supply and demand.

\*I can conduct a personal cost-benefit analysis.
