At West Elementary School, we provide students with "I can" statements to set a purpose for our learning each day. Our learning goals for this week are...

## Literacy:

\*I can develop an understanding of vocabulary by using sentence-level context to determine the meaning of unfamiliar words or distinguish multiplemeaning words.

### Math:

- \*I can understand what a unit fraction is.
- \*I can describe the numerator as the number of pieces being considered and the denominator as the number of pieces that make the whole.
- \*I can partition shapes into parts with equal areas.
- \*I can represent fractions on a number line.
