Literacy:

- *I can explain the author's purpose.
- *I can explain what the author is trying to persuade the reader to think or do.

Math:

- *I can compare fractions using fraction strips.
- *I can compare fractions using circles.
- *I can justify my comparison of two fractions using words or models.
- *I can describe the numerator as part of the whole
- *I can describe the denominator as the total number of pieces that make the whole.
- *I can compare two fractions with the same denominator using greater than, less than, = and use visual models to justify my comparisons.

Writer's Workshop:

- *I can use my own words except when quoting a source.
- *I can reference my sources.
- *I can use comparative, superlative and demonstrative adjectives and adverbs.
- *I can state my opinion.
- *I can state reasons for my opinion.
