At West Elementary School, we provide students with "I can" statements to set a purpose for our learning each day. Our learning goals for this week are...

Literacy:

*I can compare and contrast the important points and details on the same topic.

*I can make connections between fiction and nonfiction texts using compare and contrast.

<u>Math</u>:

*I can identify equal parts of a given whole. *I can write fractions that represent the shaded parts of a whole.

*I can describe the numerator as part of the whole *I can describe the denominator as the total number of pieces that make the whole.

*I can identify a number line is divided into equal parts of a given whole.

*I can identify the interval from zero to one on a number line is one whole unit.

*I can explain that a fraction represents the distance from zero on a number line.

Writer's Workshop:

*I can follow the writing process by writing a draft with a clear beginning, middle and end, including a topic sentence supported by facts, details and reasons.

*I can state my opinion.
