At West Elementary School, we provide students with "I can" statements to set a purpose for our learning each day. Our learning goals for this week are...

Literacy:

- *I can draw conclusions and support with text evidence.
- *I can use context clues to determine the meaning of words.

Math:

We will be testing on our fraction unit. Watch for the study guide to come home.

Writer's Workshop:

- *I can write poems that establish a setting and introduce a narrator or characters.
- *I can address an appropriate audience when developing a draft.

Science:

- *I can **obtain** and **combine** information to **describe** climates in different regions of the world.
- *I can **represent** data in tables and graphical displays to **describe** typical weather conditions expected during a particular season.

Social Studies:

- * I can define economy and give examples of different types of economies.
- * I can define taxes and explain how taxes are generated and used.
- *I can explain supply and demand.
- *I can conduct a personal cost-benefit analysis
