Literacy:

*I can draw conclusions and support with text evidence.

*I can use context clues to determine the meaning of words.

Math:

We will be testing on our fraction unit. Watch for the study guide to come home.

Writer's Workshop:

*I can write poems that establish a setting and introduce a narrator or characters.

*I can address an appropriate audience when developing a draft.

Science:

*I can **obtain** and **combine** information to **describe** climates in different regions of the world.

*I can **represent** data in tables and graphical displays to **describe** typical weather conditions expected during a particular season.

Social Studies:

* I can define economy and give examples of different types of economies.

* I can define taxes and explain how taxes are generated and used.
