At West Elementary School, we provide students with "I can" statements to set a purpose for our learning each day. Our learning goals for this week are...

Reading:

- *I can summarize a story's beginning, middle and end.
- *I can determine a story's central message, lesson or moral.
- * I can summarize and sequence plot and explain how past events impact future events.

Math:

We will post test on Unit 1 math this week - addition/subtraction/rounding. We will then start on interpreting data.

Writer's Workshop:

- * I can use an organizer to plan a paragraph.
- *I can write a narrative paragraph.
- *I can write a topic sentence.
- *I can support my topic with supports and detail sentences.
- * I can use complete sentences in my writing.

Spelling: *I can spell these Unit 3 words: few those always show large

We will test over these words on Friday, September 21st. Although we practice here at school, home practice with these words is also very beneficial.
