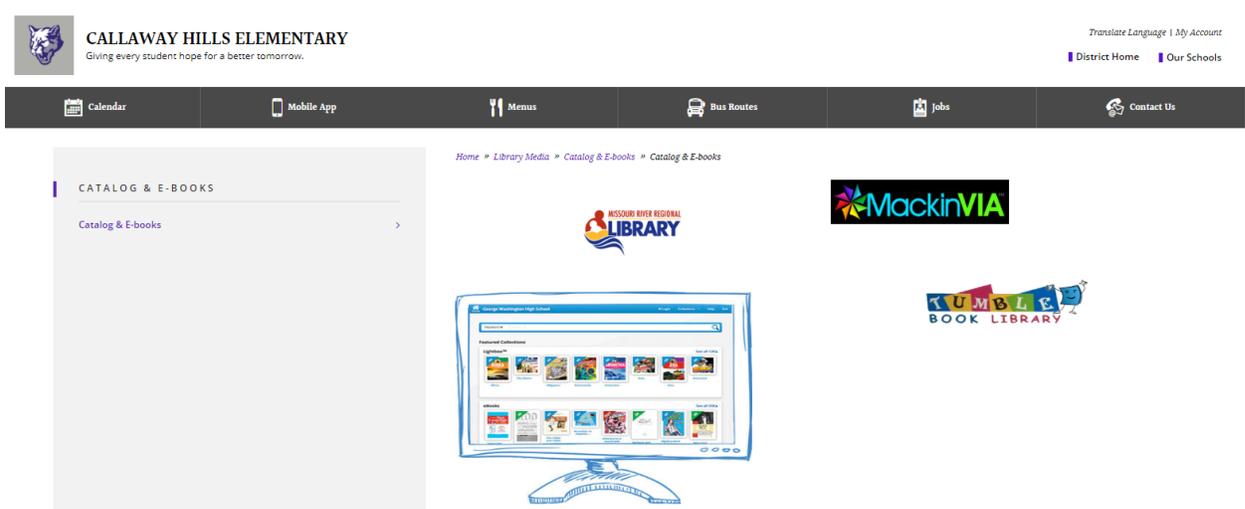
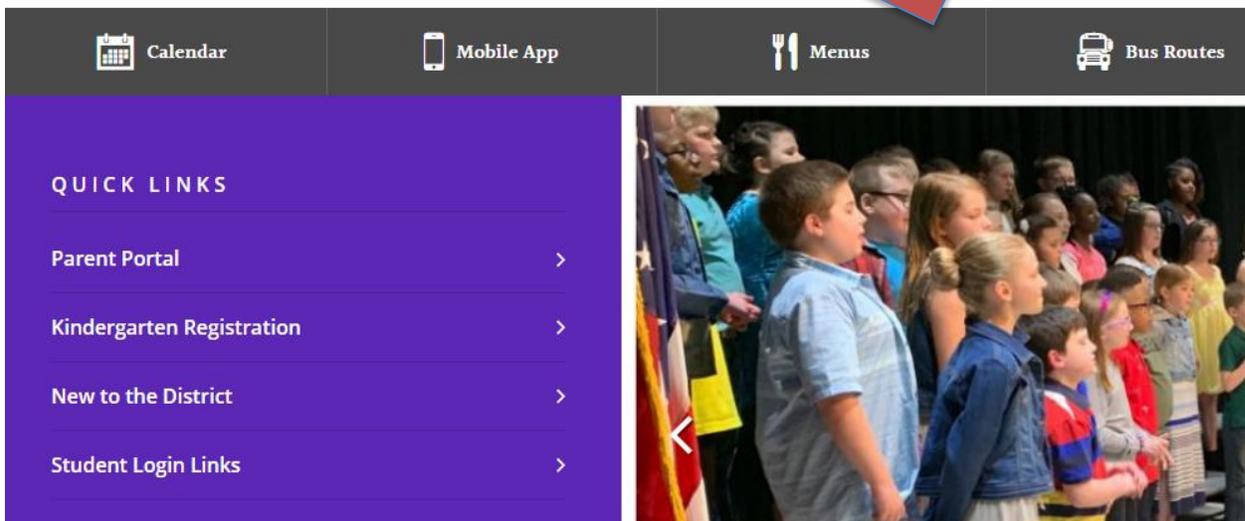
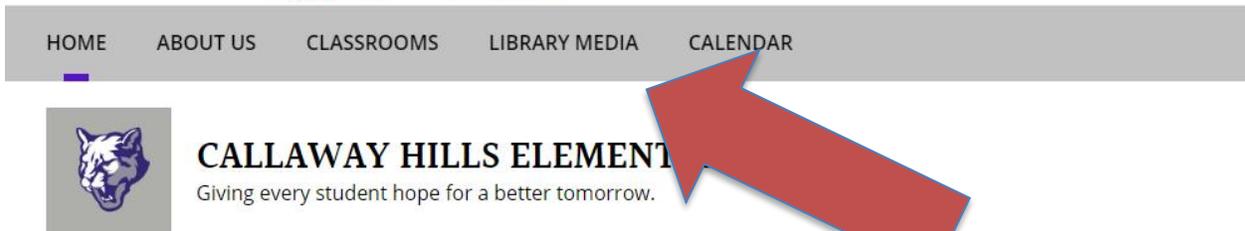


# How to use MackinVia eBooks @ the Callaway Hills Library

1. To begin, go to the Callaway Hills Elementary Homepage then scroll over **Library Media**. Then click Catalog and eBooks.



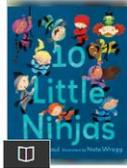
2. Next click on the MackinVia icon to get to the eBook shelf.

How to create a Backpack on MackinVIA so you can check out an eBook.

At the MackinVIA shelf you have several choices:

- **Add to Favorites** - keep track of books to check out in the future
- **Open Now** - you can view the book first before you check out
- **Check Out** - if you know you definitely want it you can click here
