
Curriculum Corner

COMMUNICATION ARTS - students can read and comprehend historical fiction books on their independent reading level; identify the tone of a poem; use text evidence to discuss a poem; make inferences about figurative language; analyze a poem; summarize a poem's message; write poetry

MATH - students can convert customary measurements; multiply fractions

SCIENCE - students can describe structures of the geosphere, biosphere, hydrosphere, and atmosphere; describe how the systems interact with each other; make a model of earth's movements; identify and describe the layers of the earth
