Jefferson City High school recognizes that not all high school students have the same opportunity to earn college credit through Dual Credit. It is the hope that the staff at Jefferson City High School can close that gap by providing grants for students who otherwise would not be able to participate.

Second Semester Application Deadline

1. Dual Credit deadline--January 14, 2022

Steps to complete:

- 1. Signatures of both student and parent/guardian. A signature constitutes permission to review financial information.
- 2. Proof of financial need by providing income verification. This can consist of W2's, tax return, pay stubs etc. All documentation will be kept confidential and destroyed after the application is reviewed. Please submit in a sealed envelope.
- 3. Post secondary plans--College/Trade School and career choice
- 4. Description of personal, family, or financial circumstances that make it necessary for you to seek aid for your dual credit/AP exam.

All applications will be reviewed by a committee and grants will be awarded based on the availability of funds. Please note that an application does not guarantee a grant. Students will be notified of approval or denial by 1/19/22

If you are not accepted for a grant, you will be notified so a decision can be made on whether or not you continue with registration for dual credit.
