## **QUALIFICATIONS**

Young men and women who exhibit high standards of leadership, character, scholarship and citizenship are considered for participation in Boys State and ALA Girls State. Students are required to participate in the full eight-day program. Selection qualifications include:

- Must be between the ages of 15 and 19 by June 24, 2023.
- Must have successfully completed their junior year in a Missouri high school.
- Must be endorsed by the high school principal or the high school principal's designee.
