My Missouri Scholarship Promise Program

Earn Scholarship Dollars for College! Students earn \$2,500 each year by meeting college-going benchmarks, totaling **\$10,000** by senior year. Promise will assist Missouri students on their pathway to college starting 9th grade year.

Entry Period: Application opens October 1 of freshman year of high school "MyMO" Scholarship

Student Eligibility:

- Must be a U.S. citizen or resident alien with a verified permanent Missouri address and valid Social Security number or other taxpayer identification
- Must be a Missouri high school freshman at a public, charter, or private high school or be homeschooled (with residence in Missouri)
- Must have a need of \$500 or less; determined by using the College Board EFC Calculator
- Must open a MOST 529 account (USE PROMO CODE: MOSLF-CDA) and contribute at least a \$1.00 or already have a MOST account established
- Must attend a not-for-profit Missouri public or private, 2-year or 4-year college or university

Steps to apply:

- 1. Gather:
 - Screenshot or printed copy of Estimated Family Contribution based on the College Board EFC Calculator. To apply in 2021-2022 (between October 1, 2021 – June 30, 2022), you will need your 2020 income and assets to complete the forecaster.
 - Proof of MOST 529 account and contribution made.
- 2. Complete the application at moslf.org or scan the QR code.
