Tips and Tricks for Teachers and Administrators

View Multiple Assessment Scores on Homepage



Teachers can scroll down to the bottom of the homepage to the **Classroom Profile** area and **view three assessment scores at the same time for each student.**

1. On the **homepage**, make sure you have the **appropriate section selected from the section drop-down menu**
2. **Scroll to the bottom** of the page until you see the **Classroom Profile** area
3. **By default this area is set to view by roster**, which shows student names and birthdates but isn't particularly helpful
4. **Change the view by option to Benchmark Results**
5. Scores from three assessments will be displayed for each student at one time
