## Tips and Tricks for Teachers and Administrators

## Standards Analysis Report



There is a report called **Standards Analysis** that allows a teacher to look at his/her class section for an individual test and see the breakdown of scores for each standard assessed. A bar chart is displayed along with a table that shows individual student scores for each standard. The table also compares the district score to the school score, teacher & section score, and student scores.

1. Choose the **correct section** on the teacher homepage
2. Make sure the **District & Local Tests** tab is selected (or the Classroom Tests tab if this is a test that the teacher has created and scheduled him/herself)
3. Choose the correct test from the **test drop-down list**
4. Click the **Standards Analysis** link
