What's going on in our classroom this week?

Our class has been discussing what it means to have a growth vs. fixed mindset.

2nd Steps - Lesson II - Managing Anxiety

Reading/Writing: Your student has a break over the holiday from completing the weekly reading log, but that said, please still encourage time in a good book. This will only help promote the reading momentum & skills they've been developing this year...not to mention, achieving the Goal Getter's and/or 22 Reading Award incentives. This week we will work on introductions, conclusions, and citing references for our Native American research papers and work on using context clues to unlock meaning of unfamiliar words.

Math: This week we are working on dividing decimals with a zero embedded in the dividend and conquering various word problems. I was hoping to complete the unit before the holiday, but it would have been too stressful. We'll review the first few days we're back, and test Wednesday/Thursday of that week.

Social Studies: We complete our unit of "Great Explorers" with the search for the Northwest Passage & some activities using historical maps/timelines.

Fixed mindset: assume intelligence and other qualities/talents are fixed traits and cannot be developed.

Growth mindset: ... are able to be developed through effort, learning, and dedication over time.
