What's going on in our classroom this week?

Reading/Writing: This week students will wrap up conducting research on his/her Native American tribe. We will discuss the need for using "expert" vocabulary when researching & writing factually on a topic. Our writing lessons focus on characteristics of biographies, while our reading lessons center on using context clues to find



meanings for difficult vocabulary and using text features & questioning to make connections within nonfiction texts.

Math: Students will spend Monday reviewing for the <u>multiplication of decimals test on Tuesday</u>/Wednesday this week *(it's a long one)*. We will complete the online "Show What You Know" exercise and vocabulary builder for the next unit over dividing decimals. Then dig into finding patterns in decimal division and dividing decimals by whole numbers.

Science: We start our unit over the exploration of the geosphere and how it interacts with the hydrosphere.

Social Studies: We will begin reading about the period of Great Exploration by Europeans,

which led to the discovery of many new lands, including the United States.
