What's going on in our classroom this week?

2nd Steps - Lesson 3 - Anti-bullying

Reading/Writing: After completing individual running records in reading with each student, we will pick back up with our guided reading groups (hopefully without having to retake much ground). In writing, the class will be busy completing their informational papers on Native Americans these first weeks back. Students will focus on smooth transitions between topics, adding images with captions, and completing a reference page. We will also start some additional grammar work.

Math: This week we will wrap up the last lesson in our unit over dividing decimals. We will complete several days of review and plan to take the end-of-unit test on Friday. Be looking for a take-home study guide Wednesday or Thursday. (Warning! There are a lot of word problems on this test...which tend to give students a hard-time. They need to read carefully and use their CUBES strategy!)



Science: We start a new unit over Earth
