What's going on in our classroom this week?

Reading/Writing: This week we will be introduced to our guided reading groups, cover lessons on story elements, and discuss what makes good fiction. We will also reflect on ourselves as readers and set new goals to improve & challenge ourselves this year. In writing, we'll finish publishing our first narrative writing pieces, complete with an author's note.

Math: We finish our last lesson over finding patterns in decimals, then review for the Unit 1 test on Wednesday. Be looking for a review packet to come home on Tuesday night of this week to help your student prepare. The test will be over place value from billions to thousandths, comparing/ordering & rounding, as well as adding and subtracting decimals. Our next unit will begin later this week over multiplication & expressions.

Social Studies: Students did well on their first quizzes over the Northeast & Southeast states. We are learning about where they live in the Midwest region this week with a <u>quiz on Wednesday</u>, then it will be on to the southwest states.
