For the 2025-2026 school year JCHS is allowing students to take 1 period off per semester. There are a couple Missouri State High School Activities Association (MSHSAA) rules you need to understand that could come into play.

- -If you ARE NOT involved in MSHSAA Activities (All sports, band, choir, orchestra, speech & debate, and scholar bowl) please disregard the rules below. Please sign the bottom of this sheet and return to the Activities Office before May 2025.
- -If you ARE involved in MSHSAA Activities (All sports, band, choir, orchestra, speech & debate, and scholar bowl) please read the info below. Sign the bottom of this sheet and return to the Activities Office before May 2025.
- At JCHS, eligibility is determined per SEMESTER not term. The info below discusses a grading period. That is referring to a semester (2 terms).
- ENROLLMENT You are not allowed to take off more than one period in a SEMESTER. MSHSAA says
 you must be enrolled in 80% of a normal schedule. 1 period off in a semester is ok (87.5%) but 2 periods
 off falls below the 80% threshold (71%).
- o GRADES MSHSAA also says you must earn at least 80% of credit each grading period. Thus you must earn credit in 6 of 7 classes every semester at JCHS. If you take one period off in a semester that means you CANNOT FAIL ANY CLASSES. This is another reason you cannot take more than one period off each semester.
