Writing

- Choosing an idea from Writer's Notebooks to develop into a "Publishable Piece"
- Focus on writing about small moments and using sensory details to make the moments come alive to readers.

Reading

- Setting personal reading goals
- Focus on discussing texts and supporting thoughts with evidence from text.
- Taking notes in notebooks or on post-its as we read to discuss effectively

Math

- Students are working with large numbers up to the 100,000s place value to:
 - Adding and subtracting up to 100,000 with borrowing and regrouping.
 - Example: $534,256 - 385,207 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$
 - Work more on rounding... this is an area we are struggling to understand
 - Unit Test next Monday- study guide over weekend!
