

## JCPS 2019 Summer School

### Enrolling **Non-Public** Kindergarten/Elementary/Middle School Students

#### Who may enroll?

**Kindergarten, Elementary and Middle School students** who have residence within JCPS boundaries and who desire to attend JCPS summer school. There is no school recommendation required for students to attend summer school.

#### Where/When to enroll?

**Kindergarten (those attending Kindergarten in 19-20 school year)** - Summer school applications will be accepted at the Welcome Center in the JCPS Board of Education building, 315 E. Dunklin Street, through April 5, 2019.

**1<sup>st</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grade (current K – 7<sup>th</sup> grade)** - Summer school applications should be sent to the JCPS Curriculum and Instruction Office by the individual non-public schools before April 5, 2019. The Curriculum and Instruction Office will forward the summer school applications to the Welcome Center staff for processing.

**(Current K – 7<sup>th</sup> grade)**

\*Non-Public school **must verify** that the address on the Summer School packet matches the address on file with the school\*
